TODAY MEMBERS VOTE BEFORE & AFTER SERVICES

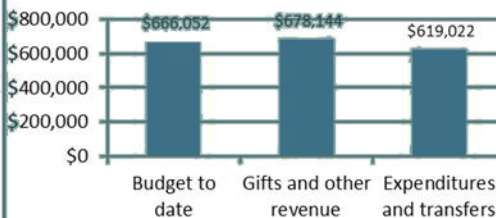

TONIGHT: CELEBRATION OF MINISTRY GATHERING

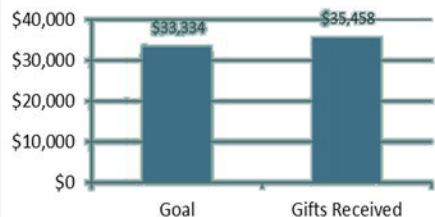
