Here is some information for this week. New items are highlighted.

Sunday Worship Schedule

8:45 a.m. – Outdoor (If the weather—lightning or torrential rain—prevents us meeting outdoors, we will move into the sanctuary). Coffee is available before and after the outdoor service.

9:45 a.m. – Sunday School paused until January 16

11:00 a.m. – Indoor/Streaming Worship

Sunday Morning:

- This Sunday is the Second Sunday After Christmas. Pastor Paul Shea will be preaching in both services.
- A reminder that the outdoor service is broadcast on a radio frequency (106.9 FM) that enables you to remain in your car and listen to the service if you desire to do so. The signal is available at some locations in Houghton.

Christmas Eve Offering: Thank you for your generosity! As of today, we have received \$22,784 to fund (through World Hope) a vital Oxygen Generation facility at the LaGonave Wesleyan Hospital on the island located a few miles off the coast of Haiti. HWC Kids:

- A new year, new month, and new series: A Day at the Museum. Here's what GROW has to say: Museums have the unique ability to transform learning! Instead of merely reading words on a page, we can experience them through all of our senses! A Day at the Museum is a series all about helping kids interact with the stories of Jesus and connecting them to God. Jesus' life and early ministry helps all of us experience (see, hear . . . even taste!) and follow God in new, tangible, and real ways. This week, kids experience the story of John the Baptist preparing the way for Jesus and learn that we can see God through Jesus.
- Children's Church resumes on January 9th. Sunday School resumes on January 16th. See you then!

The Little Chapel Donation Trailer will be parked at the Church during the month of December. “The Tiny House of God” was built on wheels to travel from church to church, community to community. Its mission is to be a collection point for bibles and other Christian literature (Bibles, books, devotionals, children's materials, etc.) that are no longer used and donated for the purpose of being distributed to people who deeply desire the gospel. These materials equip pastors and missionaries in places that have few resources. The Little Chapel started its ministry in 2021 and is shipping materials via Love Packages in Butler, Illinois who has a network of distributors throughout the world. Drop off your materials at any time! There are primarily two criteria in deciding what material we accept: Something that will lead someone to faith in Christ and/or something that will disciple a believer (please ensure that materials are in good condition).

Church Finances

Budget Needed: \$465,480.16 / Budget Received: \$418,407.31

- **Year End Reminder:** *All gifts for calendar year 2021 need to be delivered to the church office by noon on the 31st or mailed with a postmark date of December 31st or earlier, or need to be made online by December 31st at 2:00 p.m. with a gift date of December 31 or earlier*
