Scripture Reading: Leviticus 11-15 Excerpts

The LORD said to Moses and Aaron, "Say to the Israelites: 'Of all the animals that live on land, these are the ones you may eat: You may eat any animal that has a divided hoof and that chews the cud...."

"Of all the creatures living in the water of the seas and the streams you may eat any that have fins and scales...."

"These are the birds you are to regard as unclean and not eat because they are unclean: the eagle, the vulture, the black vulture, the red kite, any kind of black kite, any kind of raven, the horned owl, the screech owl, the gull, any kind of hawk, the little owl, the cormorant, the great owl, the white owl, the desert owl, the osprey, the stork, any kind of heron, the hoopoe and the bat...."

"All flying insects that walk on all fours are to be regarded as unclean by you...."

"You must distinguish between the unclean and the clean, between living creatures that may be eaten and those that may not be eaten...."

The LORD said to Moses and Aaron, "When anyone has a defiling skin disease, they must be brought to the priest.

The priest is to examine them...."

"As for any fabric that is spoiled with a defiling mold ... The priest is to examine the affected area and isolate the article for seven days. On the seventh day he is to examine it, and if the mold has spread in the fabric, the woven or knitted material, or the leather, whatever its use, it is a persistent defiling mold; the article is unclean...."

The LORD said to Moses and Aaron, "When you enter the land of Canaan, which I am giving you as your possession, and I put a spreading mold in a house in that land, the owner of the house must go and tell the priest ... The priest is to order the house to be emptied before he goes in to examine the mold, so that nothing in the house will be pronounced unclean. After this the priest is to go in and inspect the house...."

"You must keep the Israelites separate from things that make them unclean, so they will not die in their uncleanness for defiling my dwelling place, which is among them."
