

WELCOME TO THE HOUGHTON WESLEYAN CHURCH. Life in the midst of winter can be difficult. The cold and snow, the mundane of gray skies and the demands of life can overwhelm us. To our time, the Psalmist declares: “I will praise you, Lord, with all my heart; I will tell of all the marvelous things you have done. I will be filled with joy because of you. I will sing praises to your name, O Most High” (9:1-2). We keep coming together each week to remember who God is and to open our eyes to his presence and grace in our lives and in our world. May our worship today be this for all of us.

ASH WEDNESDAY SERVICE: This Wednesday, February 22, 6:30pm, in the Church Sanctuary, we will join millions of Christians around the world as we enter into the season of Lent. This service is a time of reflection, song, silence and (for all who desire) the imposition of ashes.

NEXT SUNDAY MORNING is the First Sunday in Lent. Pastor Wes begins a Lenten series of sermons that focus on the questions Jesus asks in the final hours of his life. Next Sunday’s sermon focused on Jesus’s question: *Why are you sleeping?* (Luke 22:39-46). We will gather for worship at 8:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. The 11:00 service will be streamed through all of the regular channels.
